Entries are invited from ANC members for projects undertaken in the 2 years prior to 30 June 2017. Entries will be acknowledged on receipt. The closing date for entries is midnight on **Friday 5th May 2017**

Shortlisted entries will be advised by the start of June and will be required to make a short presentation during the conference on the afternoon of 21st June prior to the Awards Dinner that evening. When submitting an entry please ensure that you are available to attend on that day. The event takes place at the Hyatt Regency, Birmingham.

GUIDANCE ON WHAT TO ENTER

The Awards are looking for examples of work that display innovation, and originality in acoustic design or approach to a particular project. There are no restrictions on size or type of project (other than for the smaller projects award) and only one entry per category is allowed

Work must have been undertaken in the last two years (but need not be complete) and the consultancy must be in operating in the UK although the project may be elsewhere.
