Experience of the following would also be useful;

- use of CAD programs including AutoCAD and SketchUp
- computer modelling of room acoustics (CATT or Odeon)
- prediction and calculation of sound insulation (Insul or similar)
- > sound insulation testing to Approved Document E and BB93
- > environmental noise measurement and assessment
- designing and commissioning sound systems for speech and music
- > vibration measurement and assessment

Most importantly, however, we require an excellent standard of verbal and written communication and good report writing skills. A driving licence and a willingness to travel both within and outside the UK will also be essential.
