* Why do we need a scheme?

- Required statement of qualifications, competency, professional memberships & experience
- Environment Agency research





* What could a scheme offer?

- Primary aims:
 - Qualitative differentiation for members
 - Raising of standard of BS4142 reporting
 - Point of reference for stakeholders
- Quality assurance:
 - External assessor ratification





* What could the scheme look like?

- Scope
- Membership
- Content versus Quality
- Likely costs
- Examiners
- Training / CPD





* Scope

- Membership not mandatory
- Company Membership rather than individual
- Member companies to nominate responsible individual and identify assessors
- No standard scheme template





* Membership

- Dependent on sample-based review
 - Selected by applicant
 - Substantive BS4142 report content
- Review process
 - Scheme Checklist
 - Compliance check with Normative requirements
 - Assessment of Informative requirements (articulation & justification of methodology)
- Regular audits
 - BS4142 information included in Annual Status Return
 - Random selection of sample every 3 years
 - Probationary status if no BS4142 for 1 year (next report to be submitted)





* Content vs Quality

- ANC not responsible for content of reports
 - Members to clarify with clients
- Complaints
 - Investigation by Certification Committee
 - Corrective actions identified, where appropriate





* Likely Costs

- In line with PCT Registration Scheme
- Initial Application Fee
- Annual Membership Fee
 - Cover cost of three-yearly audit





* Examiners

- Appointed by Certification Committee
- Interim examiners could be appointed from members of scheme taskforce
- Official appointments to be made once scheme is operational





* Training / CPD

- Solent University developing course
 - Ongoing liaison with ANC and IOA regarding certification
- Three primary target areas:
 - Beginner Early-career acousticians or EHOs with limited or no experience of BS4142 [2 days]
 - Intermediate Professionals with experience of the old BS4142 who wish to update their skills in accordance with the revised standard [1 day]
 - Advanced Application of the Joint Nordic Method 2 [½ day]
- Each level follows on from the previous, on consecutive days
 - Assessment on afternoon of 4th day
