Professional Practice Guidance on Planning and Noise (ProPG) has been produced to provide practitioners with guidance on the management of noise within the planning system in England. The preparation of the ProPG: Planning & Noise has been overseen by a working group consisting of representatives of the Association of Noise Consultants (ANC), Institute of Acoustics (IOA) and Chartered Institute of Environmental Health (CIEH), together with practitioners from a planning and local authority background.

This version of the ProPG is a consultation draft and may be subject to change following peer review and consultation with the wider membership of the various relevant professional bodies. The document focuses on proposed new residential development and existing transport noise sources. These events are part of that consultation process where members of the drafting group seek views from potential users of the ProPG.
