Brief History

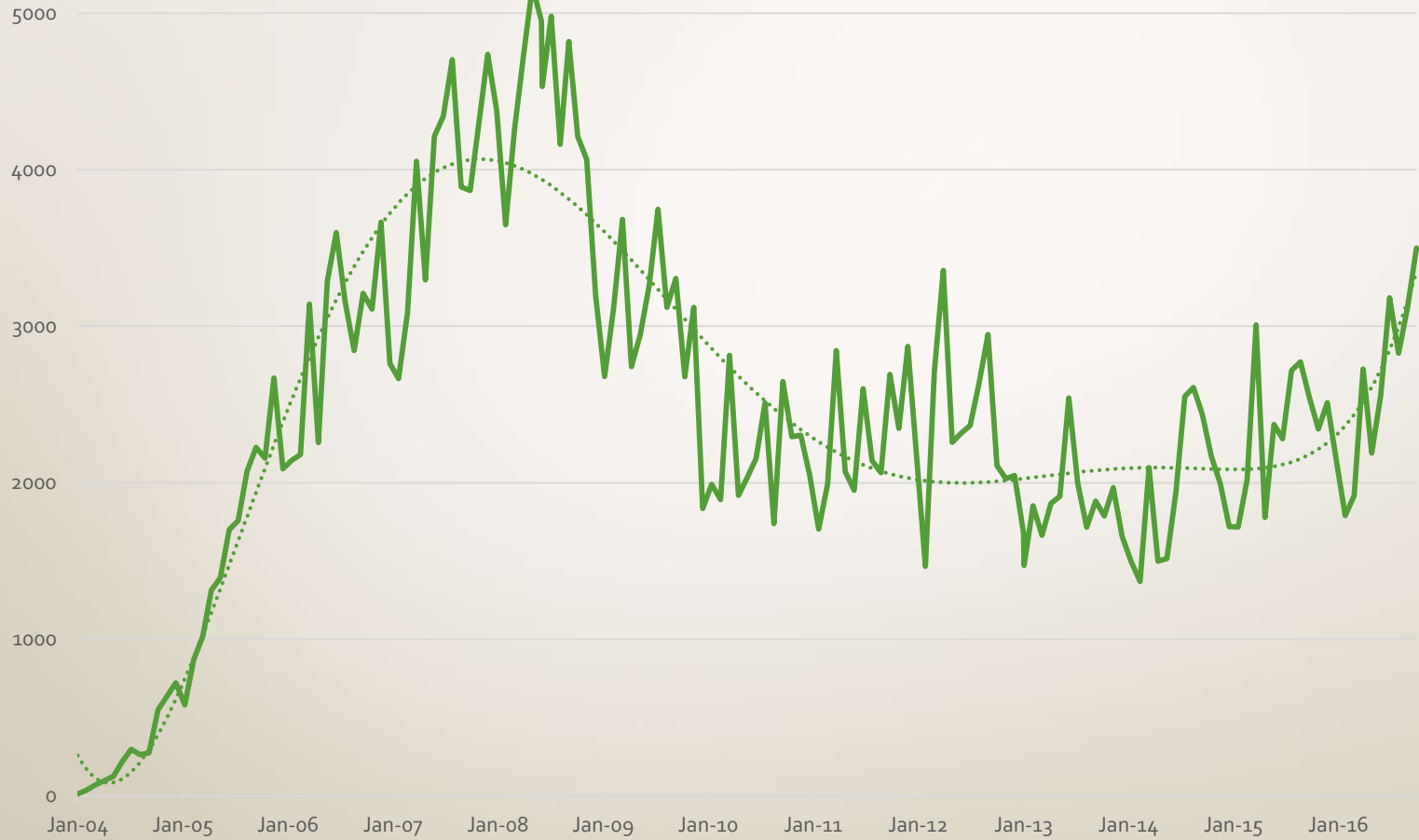
- Scheme set up by the ANC in response to the 2003 publication of Approved Document E
- Approved by DECLG, and referred to in 2004 revisions to ADE
- Alternative to UKAS Accreditation – less costly and complex
- Subject to third-party assessment of its procedures and operation by BRE Global
- Provides secure online verification of test results
- Provides a “Good Practice Guide” to promote improvement of quality, repeatability and, more importantly, reproducibility of testing

Current Statistics

(to September 2016)

- 82 Member Companies
- 322 Registered Testers
- 28 New tester applications since beginning of year
- 20,308 tests to date this year
